WAYNE WURZER SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Wayne Wurzer - co-owner of All That Dance and late husband of Maygan - held an appreciation for dancers who were committed to their craft. He valued being a contributing member of the team and he was continually impressed with the hard work demonstrated by Company dancers. Wayne died in December of 2012 (cancer). In honor of him, a scholarship fund has been established.

Company dancers in need of financial assistance are encouraged to apply for a scholarship to cover the cost of the Company fee (excluding costumes). Three are awarded each year: one for the full Company cost and two for fifty percent of the cost.

Recipients of the scholarship will be notified via email along with their casting. This is a merit-based scholarship and dancers will be judged on their application, essay ("The Importance of Dance in My Life") and teacher endorsements.
